

THE KUKSA

A kuksa at its best is a campers best friend for decades to come. A high quality birch tree wart kuksa is strong, unique and darkens beautifully when used.

In its making process, freshly sawn tree wart pieces are boiled in salty water to make them stronger and long lasting. You shouldn't fear the salty taste of a brand new kuksa. It's a sign of it being authentic.

You can get rid of the saltiness by coffee grease treatment:

- Soak the whole kuksa in coffee.
- Scrub with filtered coffee grounds.
- Rinse.
- Ready to use (The taste of coffee will disappear after a few uses!).

Your kuksa will stay in best shape when it gets used regularly.

When cleaning, a brief rinse is enough, no need for extra care (soap etc.)

Things to avoid:

- Don't fill with boiling hot water.
- Don't use dishwashing liquid for the kuksa.
- Don't keep it in a closed space (i.e. a bag) when it's wet.
- Soaking the kuksa in alcohol before usage is a myth and not the correct way.
- Don't use your kuksa as a thing holder, it's made to reused for drinking!
